Maintenance of Exterior Spray Foam Applications

For exterior applications of Genyk 'Boreal Elite' and Genyk 'Duraseal', along with approved protective coatings, a standard sequence should be followed regarding maintenance of the system.

- 1. The system should be inspected annually to ensure the integrity of the protective coating. Typically, the protective coating is installed in two different layers a base coat and a different coloured topcoat.
- 2. Deterioration of the topcoat over time is typical and expected. During the annual inspections, when the base coat becomes visible, re-installation of the topcoat is recommended. This is a low-cost way to ensure the longevity of the system.
- 3. Annual inspections should include a thorough visual examination of the foam system. Any mechanical damage must be repaired immediately. The foam around any puncture should be checked with a moisture meter (24" radius) to ensure the integrity of the foam/coating system.
